About the Program

The USM Preparatory Program is a 10 month college preparatory program that allows students from the vocational branch of secondary to acquire the necessary skills, concepts, and experiences to be admitted into a degree program at USM, or to be prepared for college placement test elsewhere.

The Pre-USM offers a blend of courses in mathematics, natural science and social science and linguistics needed to sharpen the communication and critical thinking skills needed to follow programs at the tertiary education level. Students will earn their GED in addition to 9 skills courses including: Algebra, life science, English and much more. Tutoring and one on one with teachers are available, as well as counseling. Morning and evening Programs run concurrently.

 - C. Exam results (PSVE/TKL/PKL/BEP/CAP results (if applicable))
 - D. Two (2) passport pictures
 - E. Copy of passport (Verified at USM)
 - F. Proof of Residency/ Registration form
 - J. Affidavit of financial support (Forms available at the USM)
3. Submit your application before the **August 8th** deadline
4. Meet all PRE-USM's acceptance criteria (Additional requirements not listed here may be necessary for admittance to this program.)
5. Start your classes!
