BIO 100. INTRODUCTION OF BIOLOGY.

Biology is a study of biological principles that apply to all living systems. This course is an introduction and review of concepts related to all the natural sciences with an emphasis on basic biological concepts. The course will consider life on Earth. In doing so, the student will examine; life processes and reproduction at the cellular level, the non-living aspects of the biosphere, and how they make life possible. These concepts are a survey of living organisms focusing on the human species and its other living organisms and the environment.
